CALLING THE CLINIC

Our telephone volumes continue to be extremely high. We are so sorry that you are still having great difficulty reaching us. Mondays are the busiest day of the week so try calling on other days if you can. You can book telephone appointments and inperson appointments on-line after completing self-screening. You will be screened again when you come in for the in-person appointment.

*If you have symptoms, please book a telephone appointment.



LINE-UPS

Screening for Covid means line ups everywhere, including our clinic. We are using an app called Waive the Wait that allows us to text you to come upstairs at the right time and complete your screening before coming up. Make sure you wear comfortable shoes in case you need to wait in line for check-in. Have your OHIP card ready. Now that we are returning to more normal practices, the clinic will be much busier, with more patients in the waiting room.

FORMS, NOTES AND DOCUMENTS

You can pay on-line using this website and our patient accounts team will send your documents to you by mail or email, so you do not have to come into the clinic to pick them up. We must have consents signed on requested forms and documents.

HEALTH CARDS

The Ontario Government is reinstating that valid health cards are required and need to be renewed by Feb 28, 2022. Patients can visit the Service Ontario website for more information.
